General Information

Officials

[TBC] is the competition referee for day 2. [TBC] is the starter for day 2.

All clubs will need to nominate 3 officials (2 for smaller clubs) to officiate on the day. Names of officials should be submitted with their club's field event entries.

Officials should arrive early so that events can be ready to start on time.

Infield access

Only competing athletes called for their events and those officiating on the day will be allowed into the infield area. This will be strictly enforced.

Order of events

The order of events is provisional and will be subject to change on the day by the competition referee if it is felt that change is needed to facilitate the smooth running of the competition.

In the event that there are insufficient athletes to warrant both heats and finals then the order scheduled for the heats will become the final.

In those events where provision is made for a semi-final, if a semi-final is not required then the order scheduled for the final will remain the scheduled order for that event's final.

Protest/appeal process

Protests by parents will not be entertained under any circumstances.

Any protest in the first instance should be made to the competition referee by the athlete's coach, or by another coach/official from their club if the athlete's own coach is not present. This protest must be made within 20 minutes of the completion of the event.

If the athlete is not happy with the decision of the referee then the athlete may request the decision be appealed to a jury of appeal. This request to appeal must be given to the referee in writing within 20 minutes of the referee's decision. The jury of appeal shall consist of the County Board Chairman (or Secretary if the Chairman is not present) and two other independent parties appointed by the Chairman (or Secretary if the Chairman is not present). The two independent parties will be officials of clubs present on the day who do not have any vested interest in the issue in hand. The decision of the jury of appeal shall be final.
